On behalf of Victor and the entire ALSRI Golf Club Board, thanks again for participating in this year's event and for many years to come! We look forward to seeing you there!

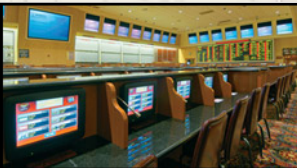
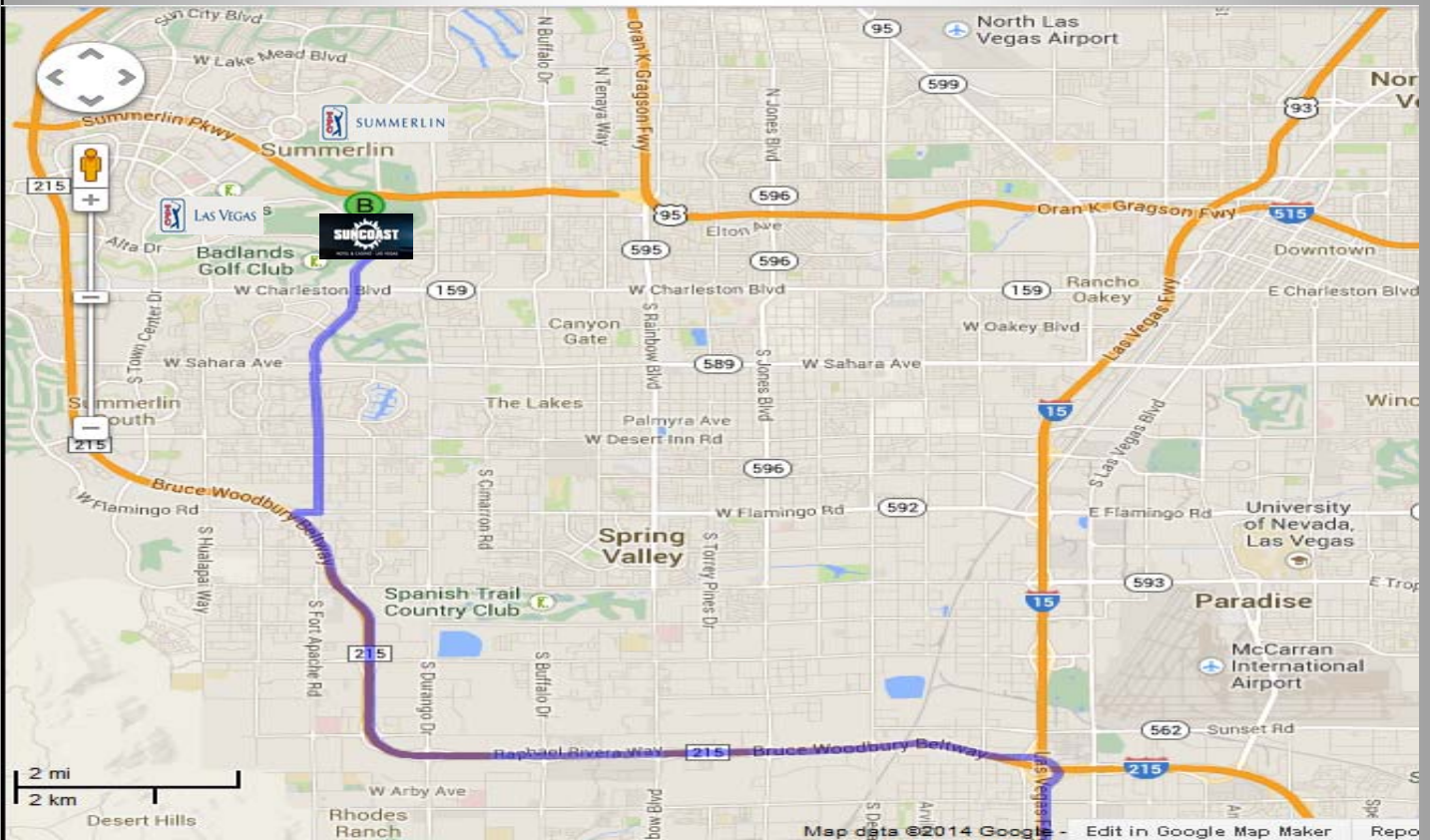
